- Continually strive for improvement and the prevention of pollution through the environmental performance of our activities, products and services and through the integration of Crest's HSEQ Objectives.

This commitment includes but is not limited to:

- Waste Management: Crest disposes of all waste in a lawful manner and with appropriate approvals.
- Incident Management: Crest addresses all environmental incidents immediately and establishes any appropriate control, isolation, containment, and rectification procedures.
- Recycling: The recycling of waste oil, refrigerant, paper, products and water.
- Noise Control: Crest is aware of noise level limitations required by appropriate legislation, codes and standards and applies noise reduction measures to construction plant as is necessary.
- Plant and Equipment Maintenance: As part of Crest's operational controls to minimise impact on the environment, Crest has implemented a Preventive Maintenance Program on all vehicles, plant and equipment for servicing to manufacturer's specifications. This includes an assessment to minimise impact on the environment that there are no leaks or other adverse contaminants to ground or air.
- Licencing: Crest holds and will maintain our Refrigerant Handling Licence with the Australian Refrigeration Council (ARC).
